



a Communicable



If MOH Order relates to all other matters covered by s.22 of the HPPA



- Application to Ontario Court of Justice via electronic means requiring person to comply with isolation
- Can request police assistance to enforce court order

Enforcement of MOH
Order under s. 102 of
the HPPA

Application to Superior Court of Justice via electronic means to:

- restrain contravention of order or directive; and/or
- to prohibit continuation or repetition of contravention

Fine if guilty of not obeying MOH Order under s.22 HPPA

Section 101 of the HPPA:
not more than \$5,000
for individuals or
\$25,000 for
corporations for every
day or part of a day on
which the offence
occurs or continues

(Part III Provincial Offences Act - summons/information)
