Section 22 HPPA Order of Medical Officer of Health relating to a Communicable Disease

If MOH Order
relates to ss.22
(4) (c) of the
HPPA to isolate

If MOH Order
relates
to all other
matters covered
by s.22 of the
HPPA

Enforcement of MOH Order under s. 35 & 36(2) of the HPPA

- Application to Ontario Court of Justice via electronic means requiring person to comply with isolation
- Can request police assistance to enforce court order

Enforcement of MOH Order under s. 102 of the HPPA

- Application to Superior Court of Justice via electronic means to:
- restrain contravention of order or directive; and/or
 - to prohibit continuation or repetition of contravention

Fine if guilty of not obeying MOH Order under s.22 HPPA

Section 101 of the HPPA:
not more than \$5,000
for individuals or
\$25,000 for
corporations for every
day or part of a day on
which the offence
occurs or continues

(Part III *Provincial
Offences Act -
summons/information*)
